Google Maps Will Show 'Gulf of America' to U.S. Users January 2025

Google announced it will rename the Gulf of Mexico to the Gulf of America in its Maps app for U.S. users. This change follows an order from U.S. President Donald Trump, who wants it renamed in all official U.S. documents. The decision was part of several actions Trump took during his first week in office.

Trump also announced another major renaming: Alaska's tallest mountain, Denali, will go back to its old name, Mount McKinley. Trump said this change honors President William McKinley, who helped make the U.S. "very rich" during his time in office. Denali had been renamed in 2015 by President Obama to recognize the



Indigenous people of Alaska, who have called it Denali for thousands of years.

Google explained that U.S. users of its Maps app will see the new names after official government updates. However, people in other countries will still see both names listed. The company said its goal is to reflect what is used in official sources.

Trump mentioned these name changes in his inauguration speech, saying they show America's strength and greatness. He believes renaming the Gulf of Mexico to the Gulf of America will reflect the U.S. as the most powerful and respected country in the world.

Mexico's president, Claudia Sheinbaum, reacted to Trump's decision with humor. She added that, for Mexico and the rest of the world, the body of water will still be known as the Gulf of Mexico.
